



## **American Academy of Allergy, Asthma & Immunology Lifelong Learner Bill of Rights**

The American Academy of Allergy, Asthma & Immunology (AAAAI) recognizes that AAAAI members are lifelong learners who choose to engage in continuing medical education to identify and fill gaps in knowledge, skills or performance. As part of the AAAAI's duty to its members as learners, they have the right to expect that their continuing medical education experience with the AAAAI includes the following:

1) Content that:

- promotes improvements in patient care;
- is valid, reliable, and accurate;
- offers balanced presentations that are free of commercial bias for or against a product or service;
- is vetted through a process that resolves any conflicts of interest of planners, speakers, or authors;
- is driven by and based on learners' needs;
- addresses the stated learning objectives; and
- is evaluated for its effectiveness in meeting the identified educational needs.

2) An environment that:

- supports learners' ability to meet their individual needs;
- attends to any special needs learners may have;
- respects the diversity of learners; and
- is free of promotional, commercial, and/or sales activities.

3) Disclosure of:

- relevant financial relationships planners, speakers, and authors have with commercial interests related to the content of the educational activity; and
- commercial support (funding or in-kind resources) of the activity.
