Would you like to get the second dose?

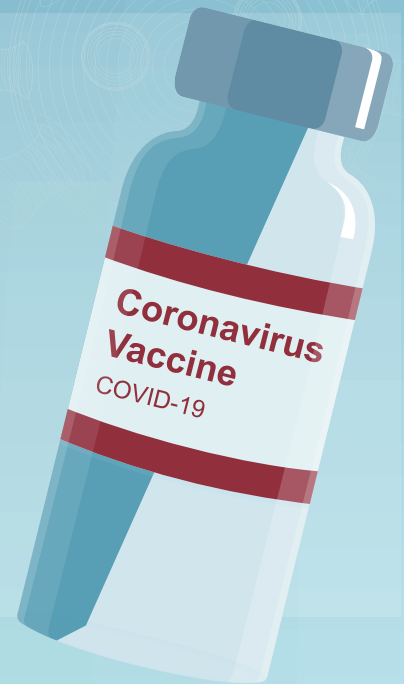
NIH researchers are seeking individuals who experienced a severe allergic reaction to the first dose of the COVID-19 Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna vaccine. Participants will receive the second dose of the vaccine in a safe environment while allowing researchers to assess the safety and possible causes of the allergic reaction to the vaccines.

You may qualify if you:

- Are 18-69 years old
- Experienced a severe allergic reaction to the first dose of the COVID-19 Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna mRNA vaccine
- Are *not* pregnant

Study Design:

- Blood and urine samples will be collected
- Inpatient stay at the NIH Clinical Center (Bethesda, MD) during which you will receive the 2nd dose of the vaccine
- Compensation and travel reimbursement will be provided
