Personal Hygiene for Compounding

Individuals entering a compounding area must be properly garbed and must maintain proper personal hygiene to minimize the risk of contamination to the environment.

Hand Hygiene

Remove visible debris from underneath fingernails under warm running water using a disposable nail cleaner. Do <u>not</u> use a fingernail brush.
Wash hands and forearms up to the elbows with soap and water for at least 30 seconds.
Dry hands and forearms to the elbows completely with low-lint disposable towels or wipes.
Throughout the compounding process, personnel must apply sterile 70% IPA onto all surfaces of the gloves and allow them to dry thoroughly.
