Dr. Aleena Banerji is an Associate Professor of Medicine at Harvard Medical School. Dr. Banerji completed her undergraduate and medical school training at Northwestern University and then her Allergy and Immunology fellowship training at Massachusetts General Hospital. After finishing her fellowship, she joined the Division of Rheumatology, Allergy and Immunology at Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston Massachusetts where she is now the Clinical Director of the MGH Allergy and Immunology Unit.

Dr. Banerji's research interests are in the field of drug allergy and angioedema. As a result of her work, she has many first author publications and has gained a strong national reputation.
