Sarita Patil, MD is an Assistant Professor of Medicine at Harvard Medical School and an Assistant Physician at Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH), where she is a member of the Divisions of Allergy and Immunology in the Medicine and Pediatrics. She primarily specializes in the treatment of patients with food allergies. She is the Co-Director of the Adult Multidisciplinary Eosinophilic Esophagitis Clinic at MGH, which she helped develop for treatment of eosinophilic gastrointestinal diseases.

Her laboratory in the Center for Immunology and Inflammatory Diseases and the MGH Food Allergy Center focuses on understanding antibody and B cell responses in both the initiation and treatment of allergic diseases, with a particular focus on food allergies. Most recently, she has been investigating the mechanisms of antibody-mediated protection in oral peanut immunotherapy, as well as focusing the development of antibodies to allergens.
