

AAAAI Advocacy

- Bipartisan Penicillin Allergy Verification and Evaluation Act (PAVE) adds penicillin allergy delabeling to Medicare intake and annual exams.
- Fighting to stop Medicare physician pay cuts, reform reimbursement and fix utilization management/prior authorization, which impacts ALL payers' policies
- Working to extend telemedicine policies launched during the pandemic that have improved patient access to care
- Advocating for increasing allergy/immunology-related research funding
- Promoting expansion of residency spots and debt repayment help for medical school students and residents who serve federally identified areas of higher need
- Encouraging early introduction of peanut in federal nutrition support programs
- Immediate reversal from UnitedHealthcare on inappropriate coverage criteria for Xolair for food allergy, impacting other payers as well.
