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Where are we going?

Program Requirement revisions to undergo further revisions by AI-RC next week (Jan. 2025)

Draft will be released for public comment (Feb.-Mar. 2025)

AI-RC will make final revisions based on review of public comments (Mar. 2025)

Revised program requirements will be reviewed by the ACGME Board of Directors for approval (May 2025)

AI-RC will address revisions requested by the ACGME BOD



Revised program requirements to go into effect July 1, **2026** (to allow preparation of educational Material)

Areas of Change in the Requirements

- **Overriding topics:**
 - Existing and emerging technologies for achieving high-quality, value-based clinical care
 - **Basic principles of the business of medicine**
 - Billing/Coding.....
 - Development, conduct, and interpretation of clinical trials
 - Science of patient safety

Areas of Change in the Requirements

- **Medical Knowledge**
 - Anaphylaxis: set up for a simulation??
 - Genetics and genomics as they relate to diagnosis, prognosis, therapeutic decision-making, and treatment of allergic and immunologic diseases
 - Immunization healthcare related to immunocompromised hosts and adverse reactions to vaccines
 - Environmental aspects of health, including impacts of pollution and climate change
- **Program Organization**
 - The program must provide each fellow a scholarship oversight committee

Next Steps.....

- Support has been pledged by the ACAAI, AAAAI, and CIS
- Feedback from the PDA!!!
 - Important at multiple steps in the process of implementing the new requirements
 - Very important to get feedback when the requirements are released for review to the public!
 - Keep in mind that the Fellow and Faculty Surveys will reflect the changes in the Program Requirements
