Core Faculty Support Discussion

Background

- As of 2025 all subspecialities under ABIM include a core requirement (enforceable by citation) for minimum cFTE for core faculty (independent of PD cFTE requirements)
- Allergy & Immunology and ABP do NOT currently have this requirement
- Core Faculty:
 - Significant role in the education and supervision of fellows and devote a significant portion of their effort to education and/or administration. Must teach, evaluate and provide feedback to fellows.
